

Dear group 10 designers,

At first, we thought that your design wasn't going to work and that we weren't going to win. But as we built the thing, we realized that your design was not that bad at all. We built it to its fullest with all of the factors considered, adding only minor changes to accommodate to the suspension requirements (we had to cut the one main cardboard piece into three, a hanging portion and two receivers that were placed into the bottles. In essence, the road was free floating held only by strings connected to the master string), and it worked. It worked really well and we may have won, if Neato had cut the correct string. He didn't cut the master string; he cut a branching string, one that only kept the bridge's shape. About five seconds later, we cut the master string and the whole thing came tumbling down. In the end, it was a very fun experience and your design was a true suspension bridge, we can only hope that our design was good for you and you had fun with it.
